The **alto saxophone**, also referred to as the **alto sax**, is a member of the saxophone family of woodwind instruments invented by Belgian instrument designer Adolphe Sax in the 1840s, and

patented in 1846. It is pitched in E ♭, and is smaller than the tenor, but larger than the soprano. The alto sax is the most common saxophone and is commonly used in concert bands, jazz bands, chamber music, military bands, marching bands. The fingerings of the different saxophones are all the same so a saxophone player can play any type of saxophone.



The alto saxophone is considered to be the primary member of the saxophone family and most young players start on the alto saxophone.
